## SHOW ETIQUETTE

Be considerate to other riders in the warm-up area. Pass left shoulder to left shoulder and yield to those that are moving at faster gaits.

Do not lunge your horse in the middle of the warm-up area – use other marked areas.

Be courteous to the judge and the show volunteers.

Should you need to excuse yourself from the ring during your test for any reason, make sure you ask the judge's permission prior to exiting.

Leave your trailer site clean: pick up all trash and manure

Obeys all of the rules of the facility where the show is held (ex. No dogs, no smoking)

## PAXTON FARM STABLING & FEE INFORMATION

**PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE** – Paxton Farm donates a great deal of time in assuring that our show is a success. So accommodate them by **cleaning up** your area before you leave.

If you are planning to arrive on Sat PM do not arrive before 3:00 PM – early arrivals will be charged an additional \$35.00 for the extra day of stabling. If you arrive after 3:00 pm you will only need to pay for a single day. If you wish to have a stall next to your friends, please let me know at the time of entry.

**SHAVINGS;** You may bring in your own shavings or purchase it from Paxton Farm at \$7/bag. Please order and pre-pay at the time of entry.

**Hauling-In:** There is a \$10/per horse charge if you are not stabling. Include on entry form and check. Also include any information pertinent to you and your horse's comfort and safety.

**Thank you for your cooperation.** If everything is organized before the show, then show day will be much less complicated.

## WAIVER/RELEASE FORM FOR THE DRESSAGE COMPANY

The undersigned, on behalf of her/himself, and or her/his representatives, heir and assigns (Participant), hereby releases, waives, discharges and agrees not to sue THE DRESSAGE COMPANY, its officers, directors, shareholders, employees, volunteers, agents, contractors, farriers, veterinarians, and trainers, and successors and assigns with respect to any loss of damages, injuries, or death to Participant and the horse owned or utilized by Participant or to any property of Participant, whether caused by the acts of any such persons or otherwise.

This release specifically covers, but is not limited to, inherent risk of an equine activity, which means a danger or condition that is an integral part of an equine activity, including, but not limited to, any of the following:

1. The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine
2. The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, person or other animals;
3. Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions.
4. A collision with another equine, another animal, a person or an object.
5. The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death or loss to the person or the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.

The foregoing release is given for the purpose, among other things, of providing a release under Section 2305.40 (C) of the Ohio revised Code. The term "equine activity" is defined in Section 2305.40 to include, among other things, the activities you engage in at THE DRESSAGE COMPANY'S HORSE SHOW WITH RESPECT TO COMPETING, RIDING, TRAINING AND BOARDING OF HORSES AND RIDING INSTRUCTION. Further, the term "equine activity participant" as defined in Section 2305.40, identifies you and other riders and boarders in that regard, as Participants.

Participant, on behalf of him/herself and his/her designees, and their respective representatives, heirs and assigns here by releases, waives, discharges and agrees not to hold The Dressage Company and its officers, disectors, shareholders, employees, volunteers, agents and contractors and their successors and assigns with respect to any liability or claim made by any person with respect to the loss, sickness, disease, astray, theft, injury or death of the horse, whether caused by the negligence of The Dressage Company or otherwise.

Participant also similarly and to the same extent, releases such persons named above from any claims or demands with respect to any first aid, treatment or other services rendered to Participant or Participant's designee or to the horse utilized by Participant or Participant's designee in connection with the services contemplated by this Agreement.
